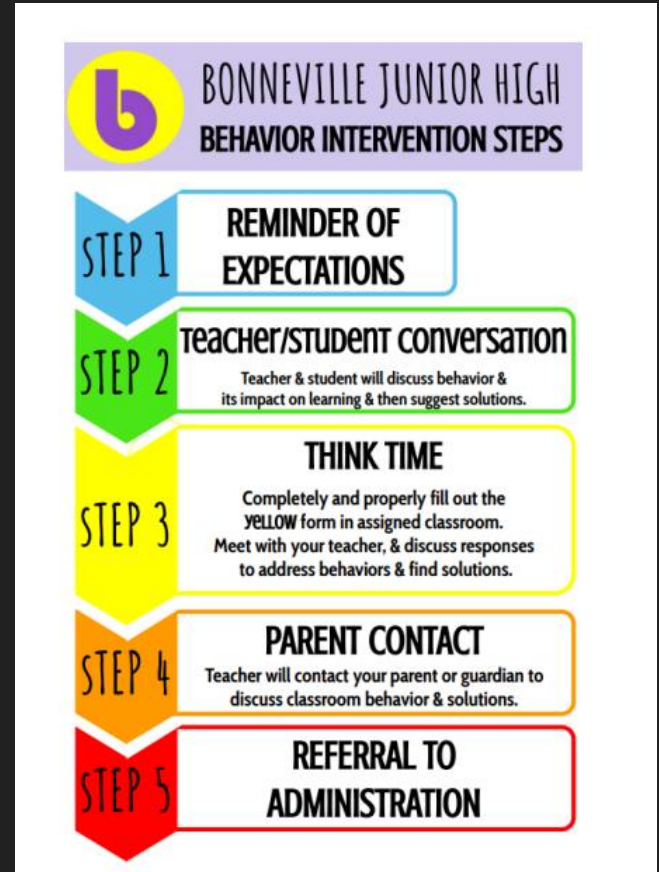

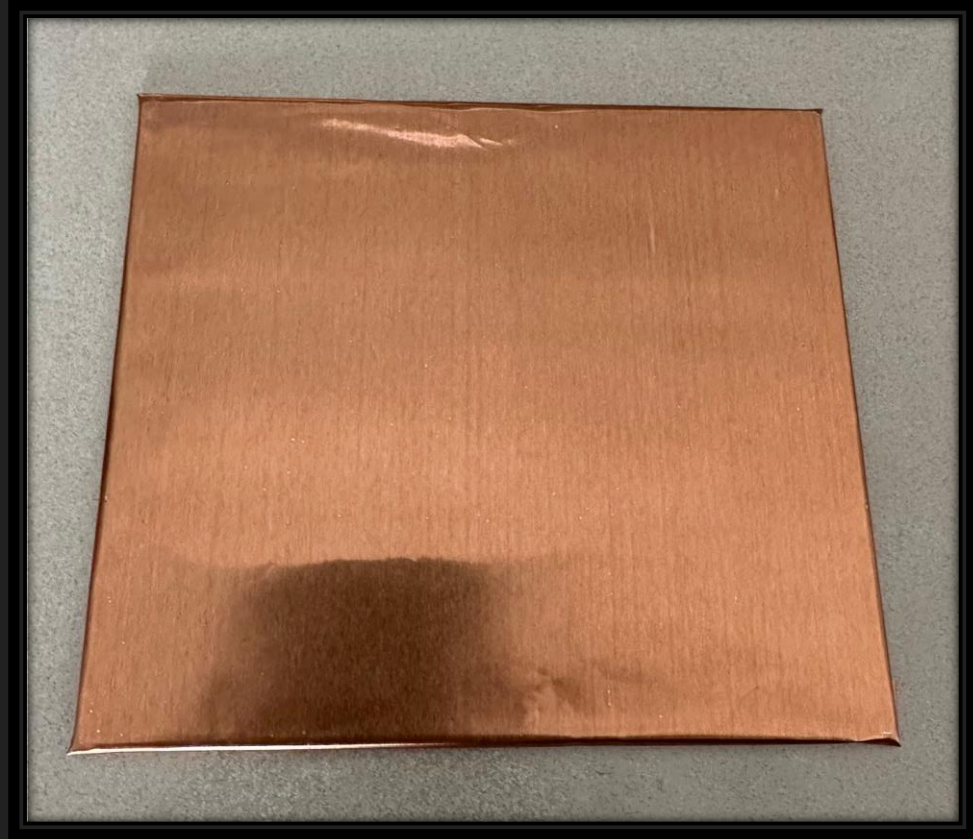
History of Coat of Arms

- Originally used throughout Medieval Europe during wars to represent members of different kingdoms, show different ranks, and easily identify the dead.
- Today they are used to identify different families or heritage lines, and personal identity.



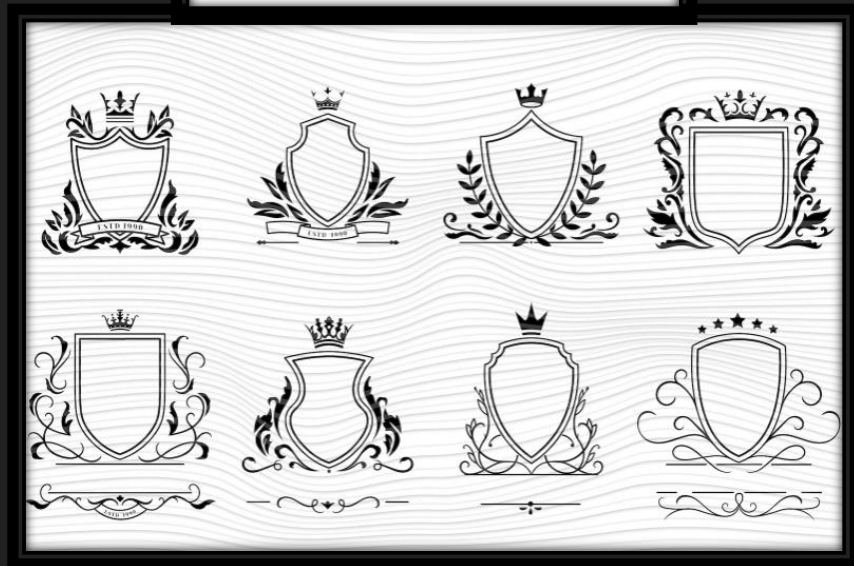
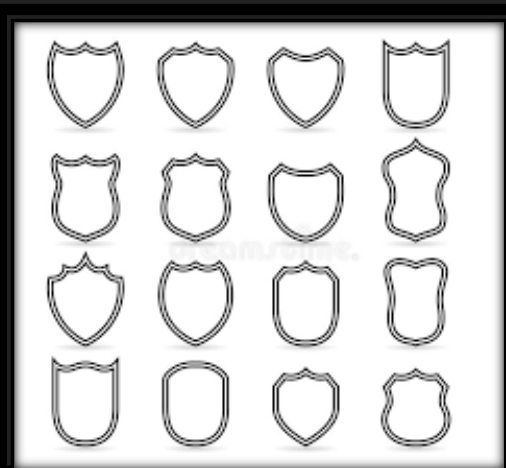
Step 1

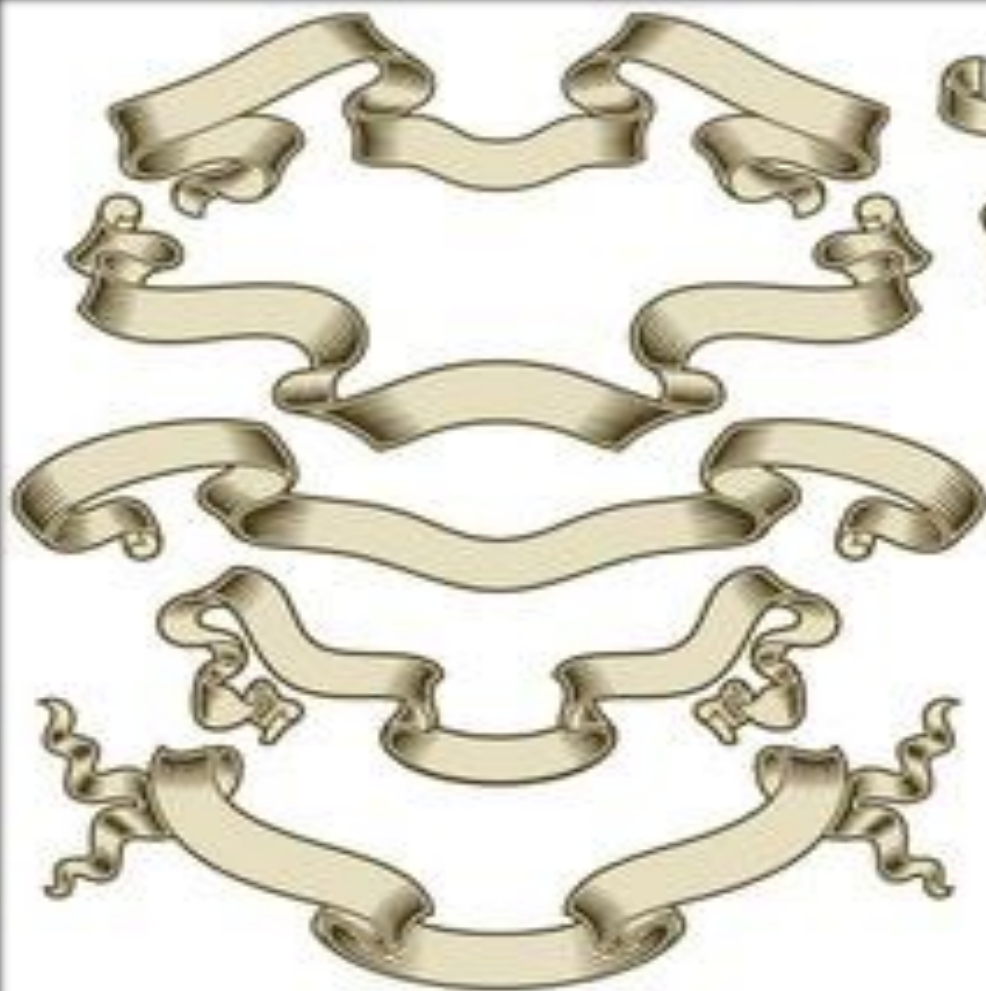
Step 6

- Add borders and details to your Coat of Arms



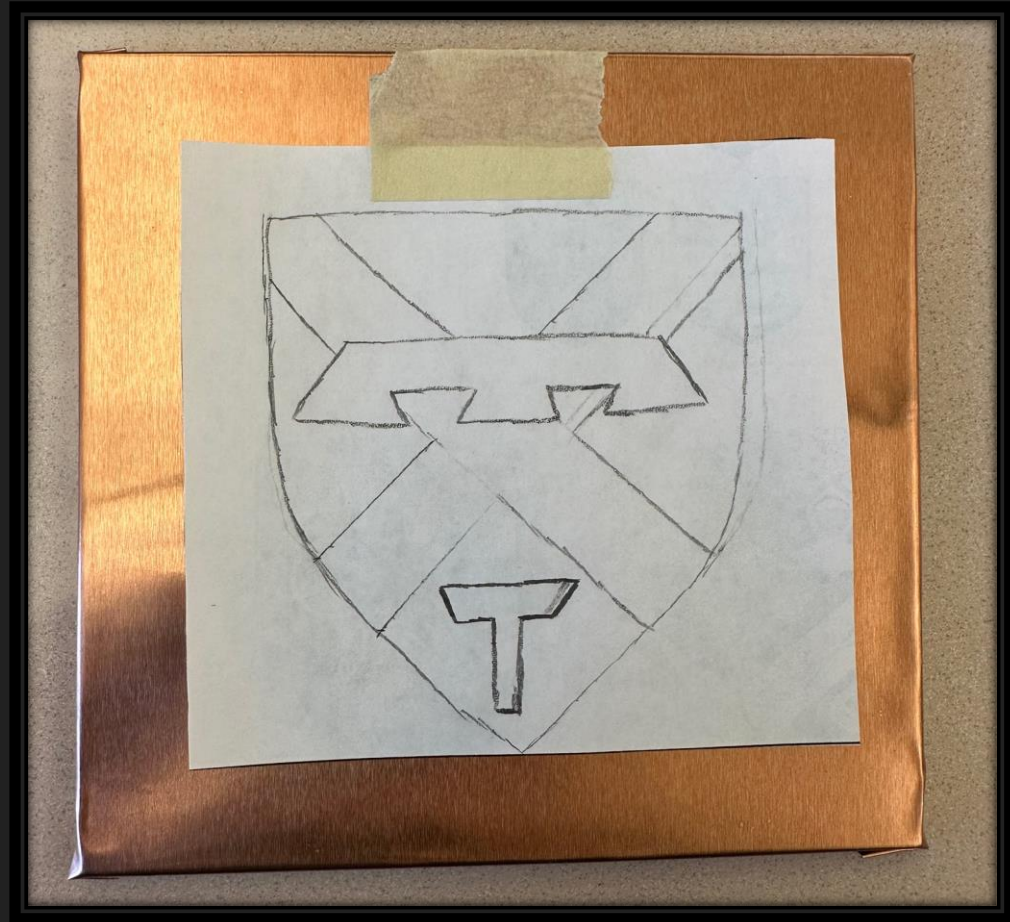

- Press hard to create indentation

- Remove paper and trace over indentation with black marker
