THE CRUSADES

Use the Crusades notes to create a Crusades recruitment poster. The project should include all of the following:

- 1. A catchy title that includes a slogan. For example, "Join the Crusades to Win Back the Holy Land!"
- 2. A definition of the Crusades
- 3. A map of the Crusades, showing a land route and a sea route. Label the Mediterranean Sea, the Black Sea, and Constantinople.
- 4. A list of at least three causes of the Crusades.
- 5. An explanation of why the Pope called for Christians to fight
- 6. A description of who went to fight in the Crusades as a result of the Pope's request
- 7. A short description of four Crusades including the outcome.
- 8. An explanation of the results of the Crusades and how the Crusades affected the feudal system in Europe.

The Recruitment Poster Requirements

- The purpose of this poster is to entice Christians to join the last Crusade. Use language that is persuasive!
- Establish a place on the recruitment poster that details the history of the previous Crusades (see requirement 7 above).
- Be creative, and the poster should be colorful.
- Make sure that 1-8 above are included in the recruitment poster for full credit.
