bisect (v)	to <b>cut</b> into two pieces
dissect (v)	to <b>cut</b> apart for the purpose of investigation
insect (n)	a class of small arthropod animals that has three <b>separate</b> sections to their bodies: head, thorax, abdomen
intersection (n)	the point at which two lines or roads meet and <b>cut</b> across each other
section (n)	a <b>separate</b> part of something
sectional (n)	a couch that is made up of <b>separate</b> pieces
sector (n)	a <b>separate</b> part of a society, group, or area
transect (v)	to <b>cut</b> across something
trisect (v)	to <b>cut</b> into three <b>separate</b> pieces
vivisection (n)	surgery on living animals; medical research that involves <b>cutting</b> into living animals to study organs, tissues, or diseases
